

2005 - 2006 NCSA CHAPTER CUP CRITERIA

SECTION 1: Continuing Professional Education

Each chapter will receive two (2) points for each regular monthly meeting that they provide CPE to their members, provided that the NCSA Education Sub Committee - Chapter CPE Programs approves the CPE. The CPE package needed by the chairman must be received by the 20th of the next month in order to qualify for the two points.

SECTION 2: Members Attending Monthly Meetings

There are a total of 13 points available for this section. The points will be given to the chapters based on their average percentage of members in attendance. EXAMPLE: average attendance = 50%, then they will be awarded 6.5 points for this section.

SECTION 3: Chapter Members Attending NCSA Functions

Chapter Members attending NCSA functions can help your chapter win the cup. The state convention held in June 2005 was the first event. The July 2005 LNC / Committee Day is the second event. Our spring 2006 PAS represents the third event.

Three and One Third points are available for each event. We take your chapter members attending the event and create a percentage based on the total members attending the event. Say the LNC / Committee Day is attended by 40 members and your chapter has 8 of those members attending; then your chapter scores $(8/40 = .20)$ $(3.33 \times .20 = .666)$.666 points for this event.

SECTION 4: Legislative Activities

Your chapter will receive three (3) points if they provide at least one legislative meeting per year. This can be as simple as having your Local State Representative give your Chapter a talk on legislative updates.

SECTION 5: Local Chapter Monthly Report

Each chapter will receive one (1) point for each month they timely submit their monthly report to the NCSA Executive Director. The deadline is the last day of the month, unless your chapter meets that night, then it would be the next business day.

SECTION 6: Regular Meetings

Each chapter will receive one (1) point for holding a monthly meeting, be it educational or social.

SECTION 7: New Members

The chapters will compete for a total of twenty-six (26) points, to be divided among the chapters as follows:

Each new State Full, Associate, or Affiliate member sponsored by one of your chapter members will be worth one point each. Say the state recruits 50 new members this year and your chapter members sponsor 10 of those members; then your chapter would receive 5.2 points for this section. $(10/50 = .20)$ $(26 \times .20 = 5.2)$

BONUS POINTS:

The Chapter Promotions and Membership Committees will award three (3) bonus points to each chapter that hosts a presentation in lieu of their monthly speaker. This presentation is designed to guide the chapters in conducting professional and effective meetings and to assist them with ways to both increase and retain membership.

Each chapter participating in the "Mall Campaign" in January 2006 will receive five (5) bonus points.
